


ADVENT 2025

The Great O Antiphons are a series of short verses which count down the days to Christmas Eve. Traditionally sung at the beginning and end of the Magnificat during Evensong, each antiphon begins with a different name for Jesus, best known from the verses from 'O come, O come Emmanuel....'. They draw on Scripture to help us learn about who Jesus will be, as foretold by the prophets. These will form the basis of much of our reflecting this Advent.
